



<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Maths</u> Time</p> <p>The children will learn to tell the time to and from the hour. They will recap o'clock and half past. They will learn how to tell the time quarter past and to. They will also learn to tell the time to 5 minutes.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Statistics</p> <p>The children will learn how to collect, draw and interpret data in different ways.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Position and direction</p> <p>The children will learn positional language. They will learn how to describe turns and movement.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Year 2</u> <u>Autumn 2 term</u></p> 	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>English</u></p> <p>This half term we will be reading Rosie Revere Engineer by Andrea Beaty. We will be using the text to inspire our own Invention Narrative and Explanation Text.</p> 
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Music</u></p> <p>Reflect, rewind and replay</p> <p>The children will have the opportunity to listen to a range of different songs. They will learn to sing the songs and how to find the beat and the pulse in different ways.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>PSHE</u></p> <p>Road safety</p> <p>The children will learn about how they can stay safe when out and about.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Our community</p> <p>Money/careers</p> <p>Dreams and goals</p> <p>The children will learn about having goals and perseverance. They will think about their strengths and learning as part of a group.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Science</u></p> <p>Materials- Changing Shape</p> <p>The children will explore techniques for changing the shape of particular materials. They will investigate the changes that can be made through squashing, bending, twisting or stretching a material.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Geography</u></p> <p>Let's Go Safari</p> <p>The children will compare and contrast the UK and Kenya, including the physical and human features. They will think about the advantages and disadvantages of living in a city or village. The children will locate hot and cold areas of the world in relation to the equator.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>PE</u></p> <p>Athletics</p> <p>The children will practise a range of skills including jumping, running and throwing. They will learn to use agility to change direction at pace. During lessons, children will have the opportunity to provide feedback on technique to others.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>RE</u></p> <p>Me and Families and Friends</p> <p>The children will discuss what it is to belong and why it is important, their qualities and how to be a good friend. The children will also learn about right and wrong and how to treat others with respect.</p>
